

Blantyre house terms and conditions

All accommodation is offered subject to availability at the time of receipt of deposit and at the tariffs applicable according to the season.

Meal times are pre-arranged and no allowance can be made for meals not taken.

Check-in is from 2pm until 7pm unless otherwise arranged.

Rooms must be vacated by 10am on day of departure.

The proprietors cannot accept responsibility for the loss of guest's property unless handed in for safe custody.

Accounts must be paid on arrival and cheques are only accepted if prior arrangements have been made with the proprietors to allow for bank clearance.

In the event of any cancellation or curtailment, should the accommodation not be re-let, the person whose name appears on the booking will be liable to pay for all the total cost as per the reservation, less an allowance for food and service. Deposits are not refundable but will be deducted from any claim for compensation arising out of any cancellation or curtailment of the contract.

If the deposit has been paid using a credit or debit card authorised account number, then any payment due, owing to cancellation, will also be made on this same account number by the proprietors.

The proprietors have the right to amend, curtail or terminate any contract should the conduct of any person who is in the party to that contract cause any detriment to the well-being of other guests.

When booking your holiday you are entering into a legally binding contract and it is recommended that you take out holiday insurance.

It is illegal to smoke inside the Blantyre Guest House, anyone who is found to contravene the no smoking policy will be asked to leave immediately and no refund will be made, any damage or the resulting loss of business prior to us reletting the room will also be charged to the person who made the booking.

Dogs are welcome by prior arrangement but we ask that you do not let them on the furniture. Dogs are permitted to stay in your room while meals etc. are taken, however any resulting damage will be charged to the person who made the booking.
